Genesis 1:26

(26) God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the sky, and over the livestock, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Genesis 3:1, 13-15

(1) Now the serpent was more subtle than any animal of the field which Yahweh God had made. He said to the woman, "Has God really said, 'You shall not eat of any tree of the garden?'"

(13) Yahweh God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

(14) Yahweh God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, you are cursed above all livestock, and above every animal of the field. On your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life.

(15) I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will bruise your head, and you will bruise his heel."

1 Peter 5:8-9

(8) Be sober and self-controlled. Be watchful. Your adversary, the devil, walks around like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

(9) Withstand him steadfast in your faith, knowing that your brothers who are in the world are undergoing the same sufferings.

Nehemiah 4:9-11

(9) But we made our prayer to our God, and set a watch against them day and night, because of them.

(10) Judah said, "The strength of the bearers of burdens is fading, and there is much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall."

(11) Our adversaries said, "They shall not know, neither see, until we come into their midst, and kill them, and cause the work to cease."

Nehemiah 4:17-22

- (17) They all built the wall and those who bore burdens loaded themselves; everyone with one of his hands worked in the work, and with the other held his weapon;
- (18) and the builders, everyone wore his sword at his side, and so built. He who sounded the trumpet was by me.
- (19) I said to the nobles, and to the rulers and to the rest of the people, "The work is great and large, and we are separated on the wall, one far from another.
- (20) Wherever you hear the sound of the trumpet, rally there to us. Our God will fight for us."
- (21) So we worked in the work: and half of them held the spears from the rising of the morning until the stars appeared.
- (22) Likewise at the same time said I to the people, "Let everyone with his servant lodge within Jerusalem, that in the night they may be a guard to us, and may labor in the day."

Ephesians 6:10-12, 18-19

- (10) Finally, be strong in the Lord, and in the strength of his might.
- (11) Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- (12) For our wrestling is not against flesh and blood, but against the principalities, against the powers, against the world's rulers of the darkness of this age, and against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.
- (18) with all prayer and requests, praying at all times in the Spirit, and being watchful to this end in all perseverance and requests for all the saints:
- (19) on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in opening my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the Good News,

James 5:14-17

- (14) Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the assembly, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord,
- (15) and the prayer of faith will heal him who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
- (16) Confess your offenses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The insistent prayer of a righteous person is powerfully effective.
- (17) Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain, and it didn't rain on the earth for three years and six months.
