<p>(13) Now when Jesus came into the parts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, "Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?"</p> <p>(14) They said, "Some say John the Baptizer, some, Elijah, and others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets."</p> <p>(15) He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"</p> <p>(16) Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."</p> <p>(17) Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven.</p> <p>(18) I also tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my assembly, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it.</p> <p>(19) I will give to you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will have been bound in heaven; and whatever you release on earth will have been released in heaven."</p> <p>(20) Then he commanded the disciples that they should tell no one that he was Jesus the Christ.</p>	<p>(27) Jesus went out, with his disciples, into the villages of Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked his disciples, "Who do men say that I am?"</p> <p>(28) They told him, "John the Baptizer, and others say Elijah, but others: one of the prophets."</p> <p>(29) He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"</p> <p>Peter answered, "You are the Christ."</p> <p>(30) He commanded them that they should tell no one about him.</p>	<p>(18) It happened, as he was praying alone, that the disciples were with him, and he asked them, "Who do the multitudes say that I am?"</p> <p>(19) They answered, "'John the Baptizer,' but others say, 'Elijah,' and others, that one of the old prophets is risen again."</p> <p>(20) He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"</p> <p>Peter answered, "The Christ of God."</p> <p>(21) But he warned them, and commanded them to tell this to no one,</p>

Jesus rebukes Peter

Matthew 16:21-28	Mark 8:31-9:1	Luke 9:22-27
<p>(21) From that time, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things from the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and the third day be raised up.</p> <p>(22) Peter took him aside, and began to rebuke him, saying, "Far be it from you, Lord! This will never be done to you."</p> <p>(23) But he turned, and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me, for you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of men."</p> <p>(24) Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone desires to come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.</p> <p>(25) For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, and whoever will lose his life for my sake will find it.</p> <p>(26) For what will it profit a man, if he gains the whole world, and forfeits his life? Or what will a man give in exchange for his life?</p> <p>(27) For the Son of Man will come in the glory of his Father with his angels, and then he will render to everyone according to his deeds.</p> <p>(28) Most certainly I tell you, there are some standing here who will in no way taste of death, until they see the Son of Man coming in his Kingdom."</p>	<p>(31) He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.</p> <p>(32) He spoke to them openly. Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.</p> <p>(33) But he, turning around, and seeing his disciples, rebuked Peter, and said, "Get behind me, Satan! For you have in mind not the things of God, but the things of men."</p> <p>(34) He called the multitude to himself with his disciples, and said to them, "Whoever wants to come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.</p> <p>(35) For whoever wants to save his life will lose it; and whoever will lose his life for my sake and the sake of the Good News will save it.</p> <p>(36) For what does it profit a man, to gain the whole world, and forfeit his life?</p> <p>(37) For what will a man give in exchange for his life?</p> <p>(38) For whoever will be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man also will be ashamed of him, when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."</p> <p>(1) He said to them, "Most certainly I tell you, there are some standing here who will in no way taste death until they see the Kingdom of God come with power."</p>	<p>(22) saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and the third day be raised up."</p> <p>(23) He said to all, "If anyone desires to come after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.</p> <p>(24) For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever will lose his life for my sake, the same will save it.</p> <p>(25) For what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses or forfeits his own self?</p> <p>(26) For whoever will be ashamed of me and of my words, of him will the Son of Man be ashamed, when he comes in his glory, and the glory of the Father, and of the holy angels.</p> <p>(27) But I tell you the truth: There are some of those who stand here, who will in no way taste of death, until they see the Kingdom of God."</p>
