Two disciples get a colt

<p>(1) When they drew near to Jerusalem, and came to Bethsphage, to the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples,</p> <p>(2) saying to them, “Go into the village that is opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied, and a colt with her. Untie them, and bring them to me.</p> <p>(3) If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, ‘The Lord needs them,’ and immediately he will send them.”</p> <p>(4) All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken through the prophet, saying,</p> <p>(5) “Tell the daughter of Zion, behold, your King comes to you, humble, and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.”</p> <p>(6) The disciples went, and did just as Jesus commanded them,</p> <p>(7) and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their clothes on them; and he sat on them.</p>	<p>(1) When they drew near to Jerusalem, to Bethsphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples,</p> <p>(2) and said to them, “Go your way into the village that is opposite you. Immediately as you enter into it, you will find a young donkey tied, on which no one has sat. Untie him, and bring him.</p> <p>(3) If anyone asks you, ‘Why are you doing this?’ say, ‘The Lord needs him;’ and immediately he will send him back here.”</p> <p>(4) They went away, and found a young donkey tied at the door outside in the open street, and they untied him.</p> <p>(5) Some of those who stood there asked them, “What are you doing, untying the young donkey?”</p> <p>(6) They said to them just as Jesus had said, and they let them go.</p> <p>(7) They brought the young donkey to Jesus, and threw their garments on it, and Jesus sat on it.</p>	<p>(29) It happened, when he drew near to Bethsphage and Bethany, at the mountain that is called Olivet, he sent two of his disciples,</p> <p>(30) saying, “Go your way into the village on the other side, in which, as you enter, you will find a colt tied, whereon no man ever yet sat. Untie it, and bring it.</p> <p>(31) If anyone asks you, ‘Why are you untying it?’ say to him: ‘The Lord needs it.’”</p> <p>(32) Those who were sent went away, and found things just as he had told them.</p> <p>(33) As they were untying the colt, its owners said to them, “Why are you untying the colt?”</p> <p>(34) They said, “The Lord needs it.”</p> <p>(35) They brought it to Jesus. They threw their cloaks on the colt, and set Jesus on them.</p>
