

Robbers mock Jesus

Matthew 27:44	Mark 15:32	Luke 23:39
(44) The robbers also who were crucified with him cast on him the same reproach.	(32) Let the Christ, the King of Israel, now come down from the cross, that we may see and believe him." Those who were crucified with him insulted him.	(39) One of the criminals who was hanged insulted him, saying, "If you are the Christ, save yourself and us!"

One robber rebukes the other

Luke 23:40-41
(40) But the other answered, and rebuking him said, "Don't you even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?"
(41) And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward for our deeds, but this man has done nothing wrong."

"...you will be with me in Paradise."

Luke 23:42-43
(42) He said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when you come into your Kingdom."
(43) Jesus said to him, "Assuredly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

Darkness from 6th to 9th hour

Matthew 27:45	Mark 15:33	Luke 23:44-45a
(45) Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour.	(33) When the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.	(44) It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour. (45) The sun was darkened,

"Eloi, Eloi, Lamma, Sabachthani"

Matthew 27:46	Mark 15:34
(46) About the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lima sabachthani?" That is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"	(34) At the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is, being interpreted, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

"I thirst."

John 19:28
(28) After this, Jesus, seeing that all things were now finished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I am thirsty."

Jesus is offered sorrow wine on a reed.

Matthew 27:47-49	Mark 15:35-36	John 19:29-30
(47) Some of them who stood there, when they heard it, said, "This man is calling Elijah." (48) Immediately one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him a drink. (49) The rest said, "Let him be. Let's see whether Elijah comes to save him."	(35) Some of those who stood by, when they heard it, said, "Behold, he is calling Elijah." (36) One ran, and filling a sponge full of vinegar, put it on a reed, and gave it to him to drink, saying, "Let him be. Let's see whether Elijah comes to take him down."	(29) Now a vessel full of vinegar was set there; so they put a sponge full of the vinegar on hyssop, and held it at his mouth. (30) When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, "It is finished." He bowed his head, and gave up his spirit.
